## One-Minute Praises

#### The Benefits of Praising God

From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised.

PSALM 113:3



Praise is one of the most uplifting and encouraging activities we can engage in as Christians. No prayer is complete without words of praise, and no day is complete without expressions of praise.

To praise God means to worship Him and give thanks to Him. It is to recognize who He is and what He has done, to enhance His reputation, and to express gratefulness to Him

The psalmist wrote, "I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1). Praising God continually through the day may at first seem a challenge, but you'll discover that the more you deliberately look around you for reasons to worship and thank God, the more praise will become a habit—one that

you will come to enjoy because it increases your awareness of Him, deepens your appreciation for Him, and thus draws you closer to Him.

So as you read through the one-minute praises in this book, rather than simply stop at the end of each reading, allow each page to serve as a "starter" for you—a starter that helps begin your day on a note of praise that continues throughout the day.

#### Great Thoughts About a Great God
