Foreword

This fourth edition is a more sombre affair than its predecessors, for several reasons. Most obviously, the political and social developments since the previous edition have given much cause to question the rather optimistic take on affairs, most clearly seen in the UK's 2016 referendum decision to leave the EU. Coupled to this we see a continued rise in populism across the continent; the challenges posed by immigration flows; an unsteady Russia (and, more recently, US); and a Eurozone soon to mark a decade of sclerosis. As ever, this requires this slim volume to cover even more than before, something that has required some trimming back of previous content.

More personally, I have to mourn the passing of John Pinder in 2015, just one month before the British general election that was to lead to the UK's decision. John's career and experience is almost too vast to contemplate, from the Second World War to moving among the federalist community for many decades, as both scholar and advocate. He is sorely missed not only by myself, but by his many colleagues and friends, and I consider it a privilege to co-author possibly the last book to bear his name. And this remains very much John's book, reflecting still his view of a pragmatic movement in Europe towards a more federal model of governance. Bathetic though the events since John's death might appear, I hope that I can offer a balanced and fair view.

As always, my concern has been to present the ideas in a way that will help to provide a context for reasonable people, whatever their views, to evaluate the performance of the EU and judge in which direction it should go. And I have endeavoured to be scrupulous about the facts.

With all of this in mind, I owe thanks to even more people than before, including Angus Armstrong, Catherine Barnard, Iain Begg, Laura Chappell, Brendan Connelly, Helen Drake, Andrew Duff, Theofanis Exadaktylos, Roberta Guerrina, Nigel Haigh, Christopher Johnson, Anand Menon, Jörg Monar, Simon Nuttall, Richard Whitman, and Jon Worth. OUP have continued to combine their efficiency with a thoughtful support of the changing situation. If what follows does not please the reader, it is no fault of theirs.
