Afghan Hound

Is a tall and slender dog, with ears that lie flat to the head. With a long silky coat, these are affectionate and sensitive, dignified and loyal. Often the colour of sand, but a range of colours may be seen.



Airedale Terrier

A large terrier which has a long flat head and a harsh wiry coat (which is tan with black markings). Physically, it has a deep chest. Loyal and intelligent, they are courageous, protective and loyal dogs.



Akita

This is the largest of the Japanese Spitz-type breeds. It has a strong and muscular body. Akita's are good swimmers with thick double coats. Colours include brindle, pure white, red and sesame. It is generally an affectionate dog.
