Inscriptions from Northern Thailand in Dhamma Script

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Preface

Inscriptions from northern Thailand in Thai-Yuan are written in one of two scripts: either in *Fak Kham* or in *Dhamma-Lanna* script. For my doctoral dissertation submitted to Humboldt-University of Berlin in 2003 I decided to limit my research to inscriptions written in Fak Kham script due to the large number of inscriptional material found in northern Thailand. A three-volume series, *Northern Thai Stone Inscriptions*, published between 2011 and 2015 grew out of my dissertation and dealt therefore only with one limited part of Thai-Yuan inscriptions.

This publication in two volumes covers the other, second part, and is the continuation of the project as it deals with inscriptions written in the second type of script, the Dhamma-Lanna script.

My aim is that both volumes can be used like a toolkit for the study of language and history of northern Thailand. I included as many accessible inscriptions as possible into the research corpus, as I did in my previous publication on Fak Kham inscriptions which consisted of three separate volumes: catalogue, glossary, and grammar. I followed a similar format in this publication.

Many colleagues and researchers have commented that a translation and transliteration of all included inscriptions would be very helpful for their own studies as it provides easier access to information and subject matter. I considered these comments and wishes, and therefore all included inscription texts are now transliterated and translated next to catalogue data and a glossary with grammatical comments. Even non-Thai speakers will now be able to read these inscriptions for their own research and use the books to its full extent.

Introduction

All inscriptions covered in this two volume publication are written in *Dhamma-Lanna* script (อักษรธรรม 'ākṣar dharm /ʔaksǎːn tham/), henceforth called Dhamma-Lanna inscription corpus. It is a text collection limited to inscriptions of one script type, unlike my previous research corpus investigating inscriptions solely written in *Fak Kham* script (ฝักขาม fāk khām /fāk khǎːm/ or 'Tamarind' script) from the fourteenth to the seventeenth centuries CE.^a Nevertheless both corpora share certain similarities as they come from the same region of northern Thailand and are all written in Thai-Yuan dialect.^b

The publication presented here is intended to assist the researcher in the editing, translating and reading of epigraphic texts, their linguistic analysis, and the historical study of northern Thailand. It is divided into two parts, published as two separate volumes.

Volume 1 gives an introduction to the text collection. It is followed by the main part, the corpus of all Dhamma-Lanna inscriptions that were accessible. For the first time all included inscriptions are transliterated and translated into English. Metadata for each inscription, previously published as a separate catalogue^c in my earlier study appear now next to text and translation. A detailed bibliography concludes that volume.

Volume 2 provides a glossary together with a list of variants and necessary tables of astrological terms. An index of all proper names and place names mentioned in covered inscriptions conclude that volume.

Language and Script

There are two main vernacular languages that appear in inscriptions in northern Thailand: Mon and Thai. Inscriptions in either language include occasionally Pali passages. Sanskrit is confined to loanwords only.

The oldest inscriptions found in northern Thailand are all written in Mon. With the political emergence of the Thais epigraphic Mon disappeared. Inscriptions in northern Thailand after 1370 CE are written in Thai.

Inscriptions included in the corpus are written in Thai, specifically the northern Thai dialect, also called Thai-Yuan, or Khammuang, Thai Lanna or Lan Na. It is one of several regional dialects of Thai, the others being Southern Thai, Northeastern Thai, and Central Thai (Bangkok Thai). Inscriptions in Thai-Yuan are written in one

of two scripts, as has been said, with a visually different appearance and glyph inventory. All inscriptions presented here are written in Dhamma-Lanna script.

Characters of this script differ significantly from Fak Kham. The Dhamma-Lanna characters are round in appearance. It is a script with similarities to Mon — from which it descends historically — but having its own set of characters and glyphs. The use of subscripts is a distinct feature for Dhamma-Lanna script.

The first reference written in Dhamma-Lanna script occurs in an inscription from Sukhothai dated 1376 CE. The first inscription in Dhamma-Lanna discovered in northern Thailand is a Buddha image from Chiang Mai dated 1465 CE. Only four inscriptions of the pre-Burmese period show a mixture of Fak Kham and Dhamma-Lanna script. This implies that Dhamma-Lanna script was not used in pre-Burmese stone inscriptions. By contrast, it was used regularly during the Burmese and post-Burmese periods. One reason might be that religious texts were written in Dhamma-Lanna and non-religious matters in Fak Kham script in pre-Burmese times. But the Dhamma-Lanna script is, because of its round appearance, a more suitable script to be used on softer material support, such as metal or palm-leaf.^d

A comparison between my Fak Kham and Dhamma-Lanna corpora reflects clearly a preference for Dhamma-Lanna script to be engraved on softer material. There are only 25 stone inscriptions included in the Dhamma-Lanna corpus, compared to 173 inscriptions of the Fak Kham corpus. 92 percent of the Dhamma-Lanna corpus are written on softer material, such as wood or metal.

The Text Corpus

The corpus presented here includes all inscriptions that I call ‘accessible’, meaning: all inscriptions that could be identified, traced, located, read, and checked against published editions, if there were any. All available data are listed in the metadata section of each inscription, featuring bibliographical and photographic reference, its find spot, current location, and variant readings.

The corpus consists of a total of 302 inscriptions. All inscriptions are written in Thai using the Dhamma-Lanna script being its primary defining criterion for inclusion in the corpus. A further criterion is its chronological range: the oldest inscription in the corpus dates back to 1465 CE and the most recent inscriptions are from 1930 CE, covering a range of 465 years.

The geographical extent is the last defining criterion. All inscriptions originate from Thailand, and only inscriptions from the northern provinces of Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lampang, Lamphun, Nan, Phrae and Sukhothai are part of the corpus.

By contrast, material support is not a defining criterion. The reader may refer to the metadata section of each inscription to find information about the material the inscription was written on (e.g. stone, wood, hardened clay, metal).

Naming of Inscriptions

Nearly all inscriptions included in this corpus have already been published before. But secondary sources, indices, or even names of inscriptions very often differed and contradict each other. One and the same inscription may be documented under different names and different registration numbers.

The metadata section of the first volume lists all names and registration numbers for each inscription. Volume two provides additionally various lists related to the subject matter of inscriptions.

Unpublished inscriptions are named after the temple where they were found. A running number follows the name if there is more than one inscription from the same temple. To refer to an inscription by its full name would make lists less convenient to use. I felt it necessary to use an abbreviation system for each inscription because the name of an inscription is often very long. I decided to use the Fine Arts Department (FAD) inscription name and their abbreviatory system for registering inscriptions, if available.^e It is either that FAD abbreviatory system or my own system used in those lists and for references to inscriptions generally.^f The reader will find a list of all included inscriptions and their registration data in the Appendix of each volume.

Transliteration and Standards of Transliteration

While only very few inscriptions have been translated into English or other European languages, nearly all of them have been published in modern Thai editions. In these editions the original text appears transliterated in Standard Thai script, in its original orthography, accompanied, in a text column en face, by a translation into modern Central Thai.

Northern Thai dialect vocabulary, judged to be unknown to the modern Thai reader, is sometimes glossed in a footnote. But it is open to question whether the readings and minimal glosses provided are sufficient for analysis and interpretation of these inscriptions.^g

Dhamma-Lanna script differs significantly from Thai script. Each script follows its own rules and conventions. Therefore I decided not to follow the common practice to first transliterate all Dhamma-Lanna texts into Standard Thai script. All inscription texts presented here as well as lists and glossary entries are transliterated directly from the original text.

Dhamma-Lanna script is also known as Thai Tham script or Lanna script. The Unicode block range 1A20–1AAF lists characters of the Thai Tham script.^h A standardised and proper transliteration of all inscription texts is thus possible on a standardised level. The reader may refer to the Appendix for a complete transliteration scheme. It lets the reader find every Thai Tham character and its proper transliteration in addition of the equivalent Standard Thai character. The transliteration scheme makes it possible to reverse all transliterated texts to its original Dhamma-Lanna script.ⁱ Thai was added to the transliteration scheme due to the fact that nearly all already published Dhamma-Lanna inscriptions are transliterated into Standard Thai script.

All place names are transliterated following the United Nations romanization system for geographical names.^j The list of proper names follows the ISO11940-2 standard for their transliteration.^k Place names and proper names are not reversible to its original Dhamma-Lanna script.

For practical reasons I decided to transliterate all place names and proper names differently from the inscription texts. The usage of the above mentioned standards will make it easier for the reader to pursue historical or linguistic researches which might deal with other topics, script or different geographical areas.

Translations of Thai inscriptions into English are rare given a total number of more than 1,000 inscriptions, registered for the north of Thailand alone. Most of those translations turn also out to be rather imprecise or providing only a résumé. There are no previously published editions offering proper references or completely translated texts for Dhamma-Lanna inscriptions to assist the researcher.

It is now for the first time that all known texts are completely translated. All Dhamma-Lanna inscriptions presented here are directly translated from the original epigraph or its corresponding transliteration. This also applies to text passages in Pali which occur occasionally.

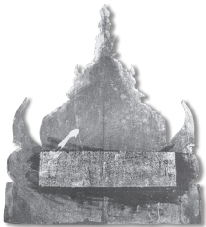

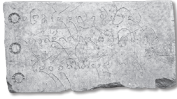
