SPECIAL MENTION MUST BE MADE of Pat Kopp, a student typist who helped me start this work . . . a work we hoped to have ready for publication by 1976, the thirtieth anniversary of the United Nations.

Then came word that the United Nations was planning a similar compilation. I dropped my idea. Then I retired and stored my notes with other cherished memorabilia of my 14 years as International Documents Librarian at Florida State University.

My daughter-in-law, Martha Birchfield, came home from a law library meeting in mid-1979 where she had learned that the United Nations catalogue would cover only the years from 1971-1977. I was persuaded to get out my notes again and finish what I had started so long ago. Jo Kennedy, Head of Documents-Maps at the Florida State University Library, added her encouragement, and it was fun to go back to the library for needed research among my former colleagues. Martha worked with the indexes, and my patient husband sometimes cooked while I typed.

And now the Catalogue is finished, bringing the record of sales publications up to 1978. UNDOC began the following year, and the United Nations itself now has computerized data with which to generate future cumulations with ease.

I hope this volume will prove helpful to the users of the wide-ranging United Nations sales publication programme. Perhaps it will also serve to answer some of the questions that bewildered me as a beginner.

# INTRODUCTION

THESE VOLUMES PROVIDE A KEY to the items in the publications programme of the United Nations called sales publications—those useful to the public for information. They contain data on such diverse topics as economic development, social problems, city planning, population control, and statistics of many sorts. Even the tourist and stamp collector are not forgotten.

### BACKGROUND TO UNITED NATIONS SALES PUBLICATIONS

Although based on the League of Nations publications programme, the later United Nations programme made many changes. The flimsy legal-size paper was gradually changed to the standard 8½ x 11 inch or smaller size, both easier to handle. Many covers and dust jackets were produced by professional designers. The Great Seal of the United Nations on the cover of the *Weekly Bulletin of the United Nations* (Feb. 22, 1947) changed—the vertical line that had passed through the central plains of the United States changed to the prime meridian, a more conventional point of reference.

To use this store of United Nations information, the patron should be aware of some of its unique aspects: the term "categories," the sales number system, and the document symbol system.

Categories are the 17 broad subjects with which the United Nations publications were originally concerned. Each had its own Roman numeral. Many are identical with those of the League of Nations: economics, transport and communications, social questions, and drugs. Some have now been taken over by autonomous agencies: health (WHO) and intellectual cooperation (UNESCO). New ones have been added: human rights, demography, and atomic energy. As long as the United Nations serves the people, content and possibly the number of categories will change. A list of these categories and their numbers is given on page xxvi in volume I and on page 294 in volume II. A few historical notes on the designation of the categories have been included in the Sales Number Index.

The United Nations sales numbers are comparable to the League of Nations publication numbers. This number is the definitive identification of a United Nations sales publication. It may be used by itself in citations or when ordering materials. It has varied through the years as follows:

- 1947.II.1 The full four digits were used for the year. The Roman numeral denotes the category, and the Arabic number gives the number of publications within the category for the year.
- 1948.II.A.1 Letters A-K were used first in category II to make the identification more specific.
  - 67.XIII.2 The first two digits of the year were omitted beginning in 1958.
- E.F.R.S.68.XIII.2 All languages in which a publication was issued were listed with the sales number.

# E.71.XIII.4 Only the language in which a specific item was issued is now given before the year.

For the sake of uniformity and space, in this volume the first two digits of the year and letters denoting languages have been omitted.

League official numbers were replaced by United Nations document symbols, which are more descriptive of the materials. The broadening interests of the United Nations are shown by the increase in the number of pages required to list these symbols: 38 pages in 1955, 139 pages in 1965, 313 pages in 1979.

### STRUCTURE OF THE GUIDE

The prime objective in compiling this work has been to make finding material easier for the user. The body of the Catalogue text is a listing of publications arranged alphabetically from A/-(Assembly) to WFC/-(World Food Council). Where possible, information for each publication includes titles, date of publication, languages of publication, pagination, and sales number. A key to symbols used has been incorporated in the table of contents in the left-hand column.

Materials have been arranged alphabetically by series, but when no series symbol existed, a symbol has been fabricated to place the series among others in the same general subject area. If an official symbol was ignored in this compilation, a cross reference has been given to help the patron using this finding aid. Cross references have also been used whenever two symbols were assigned to a publication and only one was used.

It will be noticed that the series of the regional Economic Commissions of the Economic and Social Council have been taken out of the purely alphabetical arrangement. The publications were first organized by the Commissions. Within each Commission there had been a succession of symbol changes, which created a need for a fabricated symbol to hold all items of a series together. To make this less confusing for the user, (1) the official symbol and date for each item have been given and (2) symbols have been arranged chronologically with cross references to the series involved.

The Statistical Office changed its symbol—or classification—in 1974 from ST/STAT to ST/ESA/STAT. Some of the statistical series had already ceased at that time; they have been held in the old classification. Those series that extend from the old into the new classification have been lifted in their entirety into the new. Again, cross references have been given in the text when this has occurred.

Three indexes have been designed with the patron in mind. The sales number and document symbol index gives the page and symbol, which gives an idea of what the publication is and pinpoints its location on the page. The title index uses all available variations of the title — complete, subtitles, and shortened titles. A key-word-in-context subject index rounds out the number of approaches to a given sales publication.

Historical notes have been inserted at times for clarification and sometimes simply for added interest.

### FABRICATED SYMBOLS

Non-official, or fabricated, symbols form a distinctive feature of this bibliography of United Nations sales publications.

Many sales publications were not assigned official symbols. However, to be of use to a researcher, any publication needs some kind of identity to file it on a shelf or list it on a page. Such identification might take the form of a shelf list number, a Dewey or Library of Congress classification number, or some other less common notation. In this compilation symbols have been devised using units determined by the category of the sales number and modified for each specific publication. As with

official symbols, no suffix or group of letters are used to indicate periodicals, monographs, or yearly reports. Thus, there is no additional complexity for the user or the shelver.

The fabricated symbols perform at least three functions: (1) they provide identity to unclassified publications, (2) they group publications of like subject matter together, and (3) they tie together in consecutive or chronological order series that would have been separated by their official symbols, perhaps under as many as three or four varying symbols.

#### Publications Needing an Identity

For publications having no symbol, the first consideration in fabricating a symbol was to place the item in its proper category — the Roman numeral in the sales number. For very early publications on the economy, symbols have been assigned such as ST/ECA/[a - q], ST/SOA/[a - c], and those on international law became ST/LEG/[a - d].

Later publications are classified more closely to place them with others on the same or similar subjects. There are many examples throughout the volume. River Basin Development. Policies and Planning, (77.II.A.4) has no symbol but is closely related to ST/ECE/WATER/3, River Basin Management, Proceedings of the Seminar (70.II.E.17). Similarly, Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, (62.XI.1) has no assigned symbol. Several possibilities are available. The symbol chosen here, E/CN.7/AC.3/[4/Rev.2], holds it with other materials on the Single Convention. The same reasoning was applied to other monographs, and square brackets indicate that the symbols are fabricated.

#### **Grouping Similar Publications Together**

A list follows of the subjects under which most of the OPI (Office of Public Information), DPI (Department of Public Information), and a few other agencies' publications are grouped. A small portion had official symbols, but these have been disregarded and symbols fabricated to enable the researcher—high school level to diplomat—to find quickly authoritative information on the wide range of subjects in which the United Nations is involved.

Titles on a given subject are often duplicated, either to update or expand earlier information. To distinguish among these, the significant digits of the year are followed by a slash on the fabricated symbols, e.g., OPI/HR If two or more appeared on the same subject within a year, they were handled by adding consecutive numbers after the year digits, as for the three items on human rights that were published in 1958:

OPI/HR/58-1 Universal Declaration on Human Rights OPI/HR/58-2 The United Nations work for human rights OPI/RH/58-3 Universal Declaration on Human Rights, A standard of achievement.

The need for symbols to bring parts of a series together is nowhere more evident than in the documents of the Economic Commission for Europe. One such group is titled "Prices of Agricultural Products and Fertilizers in Europe." For the 21 years covered, three symbols were used, and none were numbered consecutively. A single fabricated symbol corrects this easily. The situation is the same with "The European Steel Market" and "The Coal Situation in Europe and Future Prospects."

Or consider ST/ESA/JDP, "Journal of Development Planning," on page 214. Although numbered like parts of a series, the issues have symbols like monographs. Cross references and a fabricated symbol do the hard locating work for the patron who wishes to use the whole file.

Binding becomes easy for series with such fabricated symbols. For libraries with open shelves, fabricated symbols increase availability for the patron hunting statistics to establish demographic, economic, or social trends and decrease the time required to maintain the shelves in proper order.

#### Introduction

### AVAILABILITY

With the finding aids provided here, patrons should be able to determine which publications suit their needs. They may be obtained from United Nations depository libraries or through inter-library loan facilities of other major libraries. Any publication or document may be consulted at a United Nations Information Centre; there are 62 such centres in 140 countries throughout the world.

Publications may be bought directly from the United Nations in New York and Geneva or from many of the larger booksellers in most countries. As an added convenience, the appendix of volume I contains the current (1981) English check list, *United Nations Publications in Print*, which also identifies appointed bookshops and distributors in countries other than the United States. Distribution within the United States is extensive. UNIFO Publishers, Ltd. (P. O. Box 37, Pleasantville, NY 10570) offers libraries a comprehensive service and are experienced consultants in collection development. UNIFO also specializes in marketing to libraries the microfiche editions of United Nations publications and documents, both in print and out-of-print. See the second appendix in volume I for the current list of available series.

### A FINAL WORD

The United Nations has been functioning now for more than 30 years. Its publication programme has enriched libraries throughout the world. The publications are used by scholars of every discipline. From the very first categories were dropped or added, symbols were changed, and programmes were developed to meet needs.

But the fundamental purposes of the organization remain—the maintenance of international peace and security.

HERE IS A LIST OF OFFICIAL United Nations symbols that have for various reasons been changed or modified during the life of the organization.
