Notes for the user

1. Contents and range of information

A wide body of international literature on pseudonyms exists; between 400 and 500 publications treat the problem in some detail, but almost all are geographically limited or specialised in their emphasis. Hitherto no encyclopedia has existed which is both global and general in its scope. The *International Encyclopedia of Pseudonyms* fills this gap and in its current form and range represents a unique project; it is the first publication to collect in one work pseudonyms from all over the world and from all professions, epochs and periods.

In the *International Encyclopedia of Pseudonyms* approximately 635,000 pseudonyms are attributed and deciphered for around 270,000 biographical entries. Volumes 1 to 9 list real names in alphabetical order. Further information gives the year and place of birth, year and place of death, profession, nationality, pseudonyms by which the person was known and finally the source(s) used. In the second part, comprising volumes 10 to 16, the pseudonyms are listed alphabetically together with their real names.

A narrow definition of the term pseudonym has been avoided in order to provide the user with the widest possible range of information. Pseudonyms in the stricter sense of the term are to be found, for example stage names, noms de plume, aliases, anagrams, Graecisms and Latinisations or mystifications (customary mainly in the Iberian and Dutch linguistic regions, as well as in East Asia). But in addition, there are many instances to be found of nicknames, maiden names, married names, names of orders and popes; also included are initials, monograms (important in the Hungarian and Slavic linguistic regions) and abbreviations. To a lesser extent references to anonymous persons are provided.

A large number of reference works were gathered and evaluated during work on the *International Encyclopedia of Pseudonyms*. Using other research methods, including the Internet, further information was sought about professions, countries and dates attributable to names and pseudonyms in order to facilitate positive identification by the user. Despite all attempts to be accurate and thorough, instances may occur where errors or incorrectly attributed information have been derived from the sources. It has also not been possible in every instance to provide more detailed information on certain individuals.

2. Construction of entries

A complete biographical entry is constructed as follows:

Real name of the person, forename (possible additional forenames)

The pseudonyms are listed alphabetically within an individual entry.

In the second part of the edition (volumes 10 to 16) reference is made from the pseudonym to the main entry under the real name. An entry is constructed as follows:

Pseudonym [surname or designation], *forename or additional names* → real name of the person, forename (possible additional names)

Real names appear in alphabetical order if a pseudonym is used by more than one person.

3. Content of entries

1. **Name.** Information given includes name, forename and, where relevant, additional names and variations. The latter are given in square brackets []. Variations are marked in the main entry by “or”/“see also”. An arrow (→) cross-references a variation to the main entry.
2. **Biographical dates:** The encyclopedia lists all biographical dates given in the sources. Where the year of birth and/or year of death is missing, dates which are known are given in square brackets [], e.g. [1835] or [1875-1905]. Alternative or unconfirmed dates are either indicated with a question mark or placed in round brackets.
3. **Place names** have been derived from the sources. Only in exceptional cases (e.g. with capital cities) have English or German translations been used. An oblique stroke abbreviates extended place names (e.g. Bernau bei Berlin or Kostelec u Holešova become Bernau/Berlin or Kostelec/Holešova). Regional details (such as Government and District) are given as “gov.” or “district”.
4. **Professions:** Designations of professions provide as precise a description as possible of the sphere of influence of an entry. In certain cases a designation of a profession as such is not given, rather an explanatory term indicating, for example, related areas or representative functions. Designations of professions are given in English to facilitate the international use of the encyclopedia.
5. **Countries:** Nationalities and countries of birth or residence are given in English. In the first instance, the

contemporary geopolitical order and current names of nations form the basis for biographical dates falling within the 20th century. With persons living in earlier periods, national entities as they existed historically have been adopted. Generally accepted designations have been used for periods in the distant past (Roman Empire, Athens, Persia etc.). If precise national information is missing, more general designations have been used (Arabia, South America, Africa). As a rule, nationality and country of birth or residence have been taken from information in the sources. Where such information has been unavailable, the name of the country has been derived, in individual cases, from places of birth/death or other indications contained in the sources. A special case exists with nationality and country of birth or residence for those countries in eastern, central and south-eastern Europe, which once constituted the Habsburg monarchy. The same applies to the tripartite division of Poland; with a few exceptions, no national designation has been provided. References to over 180 nations are to be found in the encyclopedia.

6. **Pseudonyms** are listed in alphabetical order. If known, different designations and alternative spellings have been included. Also listed here are initials as monogram variations, particularly important in the Slavic regions, and in some cases designations of anonymity (author of ...).
7. **Sources.** Each entry gives the sources in which the person is listed. Sources are shown in abbreviated form; reference is made to the index "Abbreviations of Cited Reference Works" to decipher the sources quoted. Complete bibliographical information on sources cited is found in the "List of Sources". Entries without any indication of sources result exclusively from Internet research.

4. Alphabetical Order

1. Entries are listed in alphabetical order from a to z. In the encyclopedia ä, ö, ü, ø, œ, Œ come under ae, oe, ue. All other accented letters (for example, grave, acute, circumflex, tilde, háček, diacesis etc.), e.g. â, ã, à, ë, è,

ě, ç, ħ, ı, ž, come under the relevant unaccented letter (a, e c, l, i, z etc.).

2. A cross-reference precedes homonyms.
3. No differentiation is made in alphabetical order between personal names and surnames. Personal names with surnames and family names with forenames are treated equally. Roman ordinal numbers are ignored in the ordering of personal names, as also are prepositions such as von, de, di etc.
4. Compound surnames, hyphenated or otherwise appear after all identical first surnames.
5. In the event of two names being the same, further ordering is chronological.
6. Alphanumerical and other symbols precede the letter a.

5. Listing of names

The following special cases apply in listing names:

1. Persons with Portuguese and Brazilian names are listed under the second surname, according to the pattern established in the "Biblioteca Luso-Brasileira", even if the person is regularly listed under a combination of his first and second surnames in that order.
2. Cyrillic characters have been transliterated from the original language according to DIN-Norm 1460 (ж → ž, ш → š, ч → č).
3. With some forms of Slavic names, particularly coming from English, American and French sources, the name has been left with the spelling as found in the source, unless an original Slavic form appeared in the material. Thus names which originally had the Slavic suffix -ič may appear with the suffixes -itsch, -ich etc.
4. With older German names there are possible variations in spelling, for example, Claus for Klaus, or Boese for Böse. The variations are indicated with cross-references.
5. The following applies to volumes 10 to 16: pseudonyms which follow the pattern of forename and surname are listed under the surname. Pseudonyms understood as a compound of more than one word are listed under the first word of that compound, ignoring articles for the purpose of listing.

Hinweise für den Benutzer

1. Inhalt und Informationsgehalt

Die international vorliegende Literatur zu Pseudonymen ist zahlreich. Etwa 400 bis 500 Publikationen befassen sich ausführlicher mit dieser Fragestellung, fast alle aber aus regionaler Sicht oder mit einem sachbezogenem Schwerpunkt. Eine globale und fachübergreifende Enzyklopädie fehlte bisher. Die nun vorliegende *Internationale Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme* schließt diese Lücke und ist ein in dieser Form und in diesem Umfang einzigartiges Projekt. Die *Internationale Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme* vereint erstmals die Pseudonyme weltweit und aus allen Berufen, Epochen und Zeiten in einem Werk.

Etwa 635.000 Pseudonyme zu ca. 270.000 Personen werden hier nachgewiesen und entschlüsselt. Die Bände 1 bis 9 listen die Realnamen in alphabetischer Reihenfolge auf. Angegeben sind hier auch Geburtsjahr und -ort, Todesjahr und -ort, Beruf, Nationalität, die Pseudonyme, unter denen die Person bekannt war und schließlich die verwendete(n) Quelle(n). Im zweiten Teil, der die Bände 10 bis 16 umfaßt, werden die alphabetisch aufgelisteten Pseudonyme den entsprechenden Realnamen zugeordnet.

Um dem Benutzer eine möglichst breite Informationsbasis zu bieten, wurde auf eine enge Auslegung des Begriffes Pseudonym verzichtet. Aufgenommen wurden nicht nur Pseudonyme im engeren Sinne, wie Künstlernamen, Decknamen, Anagramme, Gräzisierung und Latinisierungen oder auch Mystifizierende Sinngebungen (die v.a. im iberischen und niederländischen Sprachraum sowie in Ostasien gebräuchlich sind). Zusätzlich finden sich in vielen Fällen auch Spitznamen, Geburtsnamen und durch Heirat angenommene Namen, Ordens- und Papstnamen, aber auch Initialen und Zeichnungskürzel (von Bedeutung im ungarisch- und slawischsprachigen Raum) sowie Abkürzungen. In geringem Umfang wurden auch Anonyma aufgeführt.

Bei der Bearbeitung der *Internationalen Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme* wurden zahlreiche Nachschlagewerke ausgewertet und zusammengeführt. Ergänzend wurde durch weitere Recherchen, u.a. im Internet, versucht, den Namen und Pseudonymen weitere Angaben zu Beruf, Land und Lebensdaten zuzuordnen, um dem Benutzer die sichere Identifikation einer gesuchten Person zu erleichtern. Trotz aller Bemühungen um Genauigkeit und Vollständigkeit kann es in Einzelfällen vorkommen, daß Fehler oder falsche Zuordnungen aus den Quellen übernommen wurden. Ebenfalls war es nicht in allen Fällen möglich, genauere Angaben über einzelne Personen aufzufinden.

2. Aufbau der Einträge

Ein vollständiger biographischer Eintrag ist wie folgt aufgebaut:

Innerhalb eines Eintrages sind die Pseudonyme in alphabetischer Ordnung aufgeführt.

Im zweiten Teil der Edition (Bände 10 bis 16) wird vom Pseudonym auf den Haupteintrag unter dem Realnamen verwiesen. Ein Eintrag ist wie folgt aufgebaut:

Wird ein Pseudonym von mehreren Personen verwendet, sind die Realnamen in alphabetischer Reihenfolge aufgeführt.

3. Inhalt der Einträge

1. **Name.** Angegeben werden Name, Vorname sowie, soweit erforderlich, Namenszusätze und Namensvarianten. Letztere stehen in eckigen Klammern []. Namensvarianten werden im Haupteintrag durch „or“ oder „see also“ gekennzeichnet. Ein Pfeil (→) verweist von einer Namensvariante zum Haupteintrag.
2. **Lebensdaten:** In der Publikation werden alle in den Quellen ausgewiesenen Lebensdaten angeführt. Fehlen Geburts- und/oder Todesjahr werden in eckigen [] Klammern bekannte Lebensdaten angegeben, z.B. [1835] oder [1875-1905]. Abweichende oder fragliche Jahresangaben wurden mit einem Fragezeichen versehen oder in runde Klammern gesetzt.
3. **Ortsangaben** wurden gemäß der Quelle übernommen. Nur in Ausnahmefällen (z.B. Hauptstädte) wurden Ortsangaben in die englische bzw. deutsche Form übersetzt. Bei erweiterten Ortsangaben (z.B. Bernau bei Berlin oder Kostelec u Holešova) wird die Angabe durch einen Schrägstrich dargestellt (Bsp. Bernau/Berlin oder Kostelec/Holešova). Weiterhin wurden regionale Angaben (wie Gouvernement, Kreis etc.) mit „gov.“ bzw. „district“ ausgewiesen.
4. **Berufe:** Berufsbezeichnungen sollen das Wirkungsfeld der ausgewiesenen Person möglichst genau wiedergeben. In einzelnen Fällen handelt es sich nicht um eine Berufsbezeichnung im eigentlichen Sinne, sondern um einen anderen erklärenden Begriff, etwa Hinweise auf verwandtschaftliche Beziehungen oder ausgeübte repräsentative Funktionen. Um die internationale Benutzung der Enzyklopädie zu erleichtern werden Berufsbezeichnungen in englischer Sprache angegeben.
5. **Länder:** Die Nationalität bzw. das Geburts- und Aufenthaltsland wird in englischer Sprache angegeben.

Hierbei wurde vor allem für Lebenszeiten, die in das 20. Jahrhundert fallen, die gegenwärtige geopolitische Ordnung und aktuelle Bezeichnung der Nation zu Grunde gelegt. Bei früher lebenden Personen wurde die historisch gegebene Gliederung der Nationen berücksichtigt. Für die weit zurückliegende Geschichte wurde auch die übliche Bezeichnung beibehalten (Roman Empire, Athens, Persia etc.). Bei fehlenden genaueren nationalen Zuordnungen wurden regionale Bezeichnungen genutzt (Arabia, South America, Africa). Generell wurde die Nationalität bzw. das Geburts- oder Aufenthaltsland einer Person aus den Angaben der Quellen entnommen. Fehlte eine solche Angabe, wurde in Einzelfällen die Landesangabe aus Geburts- oder Sterbeorten oder anderen inhaltlichen Angaben erschlossen. Eine Besonderheit bei der Angabe der Nationalität bzw. des Geburts- oder Aufenthaltslandes bilden die Länder Ost-, Mittel- und Südosteuropas, die der habsburgischen Monarchie angehörten sowie das dreigeteilte Polen. Hier wurde bis auf wenige Ausnahmen auf eine Landesangabe verzichtet. In der Publikation sind Verweise auf über 180 Nationen zu finden.

6. **Pseudonyme** werden in alphabetischer Reihenfolge gelistet. Unterschiedliche Ansetzungen und alternative Schreibweisen wurden, soweit bekannt, aufgenommen. Auch Initialen als Zeichnungsvarianten, die insbesondere im slawischen Raum eine große Rolle spielen, sowie in einigen Fällen Anonyme (Author of ...) werden hier aufgeführt.
7. **Quellen:** Jeder Eintrag nennt Quellen, in denen die Person gelistet ist. Quellen werden abgekürzt wiedergegeben. Zur Auflösung der abgekürzt zitierten Quellen sei auf das Verzeichnis „Abkürzungen der Quellen“ verwiesen. Die vollständigen bibliographischen Angaben der verwendeten Quellenwerke finden sich in der „Quellenliste“. Einträge, die keinen Quellenverweis haben, sind ausschließlich Ergebnis von Recherchen im Internet.

4. Sortierung

1. Die Einträge sind in alphabetischer Reihenfolge von a bis z geordnet.
Hierbei sortieren ä, ö, ü, ø, œ, ō als ae, oe, ue. Alle anderen Zeichen mit Akzenten (wie Gravis, Akut, Zirkumflex, Tilde, Háček, Diäresis etc.), z.B. â, ã, ä, ë, ě,

ě, ç, ĺ, ĭ, ž, sortieren wie der jeweilige Grundbuchstabe (a, e, c, l, i, z etc.).

2. Verweisungen stehen vor gleichlautenden Einträgen.
3. In der Sortierung wird nicht zwischen persönlichen Namen und Nachnamen unterschieden. Persönliche Namen mit Beinamen und Familiennamen mit Vornamen werden gleichrangig behandelt. Römische Ordnungszahlen werden in der Sortierung persönlicher Namen übergangen, ebenso Präpositionen wie von, de, di etc.
4. Doppelnamen mit und ohne Bindestrich sind gleichlautenden Namen nachgeordnet.
5. Bei Namensgleichheit erfolgt die weitere Sortierung chronologisch.
6. Alphanumerische und andere Zeichen gehen dem Buchstaben a voran.

5. Namensansetzung

Für die Ansetzung von Namen gelten folgende Besonderheiten:

1. Bei portugiesischen und brasilianischen Namen wird, nach dem Vorbild der „Biblioteca Luso-Brasileira“, immer der letzte Familienname zugrunde gelegt, auch dann, wenn die Person in der Regel unter einer Kombination ihrer beiden letzten Nachnamen zitiert wird.
2. Kyrillische Zeichen wurden aus der Originalsprache nach DIN-Norm 1460 transliteriert (ж → ž, ш → š, ч → č).
3. Bei einigen slawischen Namensformen, vor allem aus englischen, amerikanischen und französischen Quellen, wurde der Name, wenn keine slawische Ursprungsform in den Materialien verzeichnet war, in der in der Quelle ausgewiesenen Schreibweise belassen. So können z.B. Namen, die im slawischen Ursprung auf -iċ enden, auch mit den Endungen -itsch, -ich etc. auftreten.
4. Bei älteren deutschen Namen besteht die Möglichkeit unterschiedlicher Schreibweisen wie z.B. Claus für Klaus, oder Boese für Böse. Mittels Verweisen werden die verschiedenen Formen ausgewiesen.
5. Für die Bände 10 bis 16 gilt: Pseudonyme, die der Struktur von Vorname und Nachname folgen, werden unter dem Nachnamen angesetzt. Pseudonyme, die als zusammengesetzte Begriffe zu verstehen sind, werden unter deren ersten Wort angesetzt, wobei Artikel für die Sortierung nicht berücksichtigt werden.

Notes pour l'utilisateur

1. Sujet et contenu de l'information

La littérature sur les pseudonymes disponible au niveau international est vaste. De 400 à 500 ouvrages traitent ce thème en détail, mais la plupart d'entre eux le font seulement sous un angle régional ou thématique. Une encyclopédie globale et interdisciplinaire faisait défaut jusqu'ici. La présente *Encyclopédie Internationale des Pseudonymes* comble cette lacune et constitue sous cette forme et dans cette ampleur un projet unique. L'*Encyclopédie Internationale des Pseudonymes* réunit pour la première fois dans un seul et même ouvrage les pseudonymes à l'échelle mondiale et provenant de tous les métiers et de toutes les époques.

Environ 635.000 pseudonymes d'env. 270.000 personnes sont ici attestés et décodés. Les tomes 1 à 9 répertorient les vrais noms dans un ordre alphabétique. Sont également mentionnés ici les dates de naissance et de décès, les lieux de naissance et de décès, la profession, la nationalité, les pseudonymes sous lesquels la personne était connue et enfin la/les source(s) utilisée(s). Dans la deuxième partie, comprenant les tomes 10 à 16, les pseudonymes, classés par ordre alphabétique, sont assignés aux vrais noms correspondants.

Afin d'offrir à l'utilisateur une base d'information aussi large que possible, on a renoncé à une interprétation étroite de la notion de pseudonyme. Ont été répertoriés non seulement des pseudonymes au sens strict, tels que noms d'artistes, surnoms, anagrammes, hellénisations et latinisations ou encore mystifications (courantes surtout dans les sphères linguistiques ibérique et néerlandaise ainsi qu'en Asie orientale). Mais on trouve en outre dans de nombreux cas des sobriquets, des noms de jeune fille et des noms acquis par mariage, des noms religieux et des noms pontificaux, ou encore des initiales, des sigles (importants dans les sphères linguistiques hongroise et slave) ainsi que des abréviations. Dans une moindre mesure, des anonymes ont également été repris.

Pour l'élaboration de l'*Encyclopédie Internationale des Pseudonymes*, de nombreux ouvrages de référence ont été dépouillés et assemblés. Ce travail a été complété ultérieurement par des recherches, entre autres sur Internet, permettant d'assigner aux noms et aux pseudonymes des données supplémentaires sur la profession, le pays, les dates de naissance et de mort, et d'aider l'utilisateur à identifier plus sûrement la personne recherchée. En dépit de tous les efforts entrepris pour garantir l'exactitude et l'intégralité des données, il est possible que dans des cas isolés des erreurs ou des attributions erronées aient été reprises des sources. Par ailleurs, il n'a pas toujours été possible de trouver des données plus précises sur certaines personnes.

2. Structure des articles

Un article biographique complet est construit comme suit :

A l'intérieur d'un même article, les pseudonymes sont classés par ordre alphabétique.

Dans la deuxième partie de l'édition (tomes 10 à 16), les pseudonymes renvoient à l'entrée principale du vrai nom. Un article est construit comme suit :

Pseudonyme [nom de famille et/ou notion], prénom et/ou épithètes faisant partie du nom → Vrai nom de la personne, prénom (éventuellement épithètes faisant partie du nom)

Lorsqu'un pseudonyme est utilisé par plusieurs personnes, les vrais noms sont classés par ordre alphabétique.

3. Contenu des articles

1. **Nom** : Sont donnés le nom, le prénom et, si nécessaire, les épithètes faisant partie du nom et les variantes du nom. Ces dernières sont mises entre crochets []. Les variantes du nom sont indiquées sous l'entrée principale par «or» ou par «see also». Une flèche (→) renvoie d'une variante d'un nom à l'entrée principale.
2. **Dates de naissance et de décès** : Dans l'ouvrage sont données toutes les dates mentionnées dans les sources. Lorsque l'année de naissance ou de décès fait défaut, des dates connues de la vie du personnage sont indiquées entre crochets, p. ex. [1835] ou [1875-1905]. Des dates divergentes ou douteuses ont été assorties d'un point d'interrogation ou mises entre parenthèses.
3. Les **noms de lieu** ont été repris tels quels des sources. Dans quelques rares cas (p. ex. les capitales), les noms de lieu ont été traduits en anglais ou en allemand. Les noms de lieu composés (p. ex. Bernau bei Berlin ou Kostelec u Holešova) sont présentés avec une barre oblique (p. ex. Bernau/Berlin ou Kostelec/Holešova). Par ailleurs, les unités administratives régionales (telles que les cantons, etc.) sont indiquées par «gov.» ou «district».
4. **Professions** : Les noms de profession rendent compte aussi précisément que possible du champ d'activité de la personne concernée. Dans des cas isolés, il ne s'agit pas de noms de profession au sens propre, mais plutôt de termes explicatifs, comme par exemple des

indications sur les relations de parenté ou sur les fonctions exercées à titre honorifique. Pour faciliter l'utilisation internationale de l'encyclopédie, les noms de profession sont donnés en anglais.

5. **Pays** : La nationalité et/ou le pays de naissance ou de séjour figurent en anglais. Notamment pour les personnes ayant vécu au XX^e siècle, la carte géopolitique et le nom actuels des nations ont servi de base. Pour les personnes ayant vécu aux siècles précédents, il a été tenu compte des frontières des nations de l'époque. Pour l'histoire plus ancienne, les noms consacrés ont été également retenus (Roman Empire, Athens, Persia, etc.). Dans les cas où des informations précises sur la nation feraient défaut, des noms de région ont été utilisés (Arabia, South America, Africa). Généralement, la nationalité et le pays de naissance ou de séjour d'une personne ont été tirés des données contenues dans les sources. Lorsque de telles données font défaut, l'information sur le pays a été déduite, dans certains cas isolés, du lieu de naissance ou de décès ou bien à partir d'autres données contenues dans les sources. Les pays de l'Europe centrale, de l'Est et du Sud-Est qui faisaient partie de l'empire des Habsbourg et la tripartition de la Pologne présentent une particularité quant aux données sur la nationalité et/ou le pays de naissance ou de séjour. Dans ces cas là, et à quelques exceptions près, la mention du pays a été omise. On trouve dans l'ouvrage des renvois à plus de 180 nations au total.
6. Les **pseudonymes** sont répertoriés par ordre alphabétique. Les formes de nom différentes et les variantes orthographiques ont été mentionnées lorsqu'elles étaient connues. Des initiales, importantes dans la sphère slave, ainsi que des anonymes (Author of ...) ont été également mentionnés.
7. **Sources** : Chaque article indique les sources dans lesquelles la personne est citée. Les sources sont signalées par des abréviations. Nous renvoyons ici à la table des «Abréviations des sources». Les données bibliographiques complètes des sources utilisées se trouvent dans la «Liste des sources». Les entrées qui ne renvoient pas à une source sont toutes le résultat de recherches sur Internet.

4. Classement

1. Les entrées sont classées en ordre alphabétique de A à Z. Les caractères ä, ö, ü, ø, œ, ő sont traités comme ae, oe,

ue. Tous les autres caractères accentués (accent grave, accent aigu, accent circonflexe, tilde, háček, diérèse, etc.), p.ex. â, â, à, ë, ë, ç, ĺ, ĺ, ı, ž, sont traités comme les caractères correspondants sans accent (a, e, c, l, i, z, etc.).

2. Les renvois sont placés avant les entrées homographes.
3. Dans le classement, il n'est pas fait de distinction entre nom individuel et nom de famille. Les noms individuels avec épithètes faisant partie du nom et les noms de famille avec prénoms sont traités de la même façon. Les chiffres romains, de même que les prépositions telles que von, de, di, etc. n'ont pas été pris en compte dans le classement.
4. Les noms composés avec ou sans trait d'union sont classés après les noms simples homonymes.
5. Les homonymes suivent un classement chronologique.
6. Les caractères alphanumériques et autres sont classés avant la lettre A.

5. Forme des noms

En ce qui concerne la forme des noms, les particularités suivantes ont été appliquées :

1. Pour les noms portugais et brésiliens, suivant l'exemple de la «Biblioteca Luso-Brasileira», le dernier nom de famille a toujours été pris pour base, même lorsque la personne est généralement citée sous ses deux derniers noms.
2. Les caractères cyrilliques ont été translittérés de la langue de départ selon la norme DIN 1460 (ж → ž, ии → š, ч → č).
3. Pour certains noms slaves, tirés surtout de sources anglaises, américaines et françaises, l'orthographe a été laissée telle que dans les sources, lorsque aucune forme initiale slave n'est consignée dans les documents. Ainsi par exemple, des noms slaves qui, à l'origine, se terminent par -ič, peuvent se finir en -itsch, -ich, etc.
4. Pour certains noms allemands plus anciens, des orthographes différentes peuvent exister, comme, par exemple, Claus pour Klaus ou Boese pour Böse. Les différentes formes sont indiquées à l'aide de renvois.
5. Pour les tomes 10 à 16 : Les pseudonymes ayant une structure prénom + nom de famille sont répertoriés sous le nom de famille. Les pseudonymes constitués de mots composés sont rangés sous le premier mot. Les articles n'ont pas été pris en compte dans le classement.

Avvertenze

1. Scopi e criteri dell'opera

Sugli pseudonimi esiste una ricca letteratura internazionale. Dalle quattrocento alle cinquecento pubblicazioni si occupano molto dettagliatamente di questa tematica, ma quasi tutte partono da una visuale localmente limitata, oppure s'incentrano su fenomeni particolari. Mancava fino ad oggi un'opera enciclopedica globale, e che abbracciasse tutte le discipline. Questo *Dizionario internazionale degli pseudonimi* colma tale lacuna: unico nel suo genere, in questa forma e in quest'ampiezza, considera per la prima volta gli pseudonimi di tutto il mondo, senza limiti cronologici o di settori professionali.

Il *Dizionario* documenta e chiarisce circa 635.000 pseudonimi, appartenenti a circa 270.000 persone. I volumi dal I al IX (parte I) registrano in ordine alfabetico nomi e cognomi. Forniscono inoltre: anno e luogo di nascita, anno e luogo della morte, professione, nazionalità, gli pseudonimi sotto il quale il personaggio era noto, e infine le fonti utilizzate. I voll. IX-XVI (parte II) registrano in ordine alfabetico gli pseudonimi, riferendoli alle persone reali.

Per offrire al lettore la più ampia base d'informazione possibile, ci si è intenzionalmente astenuti da un'interpretazione restrittiva del concetto di pseudonimo. Non ci siamo limitati quindi a registrare solo pseudonimi in senso stretto, come nomi di artisti, nomi di copertura, anagrammi, grecizzazioni, latinizzazioni e interpretazioni mistificatorie del nome (secondo una prassi in uso specialmente in ambito linguistico spagnolo e olandese, come anche in quello dell'Asia orientale). In molti casi sono riportati anche i soprannomi, e per le donne i cognomi di nascita e quelli acquisiti col matrimonio, i nomi assunti all'interno di ordini religiosi e i nomi dei papi, e inoltre iniziali e firme abbreviate o sigle (frequenti soprattutto in ambienti ungheresi e di lingua slava) e ogni tipo di abbreviazione. In minor misura è stato possibile registrare anche gli anonimi.

Un'imponente mole di opere di consultazione è stata vagliata e messa a confronto per la realizzazione del *Dizionario internazionale degli pseudonimi*. Inoltre, allo scopo di corredare nomi e pseudonimi di ulteriori informazioni su professione, nazionalità e dati biografici, ci si è avvalsi anche di altri strumenti di ricerca, p.e. di Internet, così da consentire al lettore un'identificazione più facile e sicura della persona cercata. È ovvio che, malgrado il nostro impegno di completezza e precisione, non si possa escludere che in singoli casi non si siano insinuati nel testo errori derivati dalle fonti. In rari casi non è stato possibile fornire informazioni più circostanziate.

Nella seconda parte dell'opera (voll. X-XVI) si risale dallo pseudonimo al nome anagrafico, rimandando alla trattazione più completa della prima parte.

3. Le singole voci in particolare

1. **Il nome:** Le singole voci riportano: nome proprio, cognome, e, eventualmente, epiteto o varianti del nome, queste ultime fra parentesi quadre []. Nella trattazione principale le varianti sono precedute da *or* o da *see also*. La freccia (→) rimanda dalle varianti alla voce principale.
2. **Informazioni cronologiche:** L'opera riporta tutte le date biografiche reperibili nelle fonti. Se le date di nascita o di morte non sono note, si registrano fra parentesi quadre [] le date a disposizione, p.e. [1835] oppure [1875-1905]. Date divergenti o dubbie sono contrassegnate da un punto interrogativo o riportate fra parentesi tonde.
3. **Indicazioni di luogo:** Sono riportate sulla base della documentazione esistente. Solo in rari casi (p. e. se si tratta di capitali) i nomi geografici sono tradotti in inglese o in tedesco. Nei nomi di luogo composti da più termini (p. e. Bernau bei Berlin, Kostelec u Holešova) si fa uso delle barre (Bernau/Berlin, Kostelec/Holešova). I nomi di circoscrizioni regionali (gouvernement, Kreis, ecc.) sono riportate così: gov., district.
4. **Professioni:** L'indicazione della professione ha lo scopo di definire in un ambito possibilmente preciso l'attività della persona considerata. In singoli casi, in mancanza di notizie sulla professione in senso stretto, si

supplisce con altre informazioni, p. e. su rapporti di parentela o su funzioni di prestigio assunte dal personaggio. Per rendere più facile la consultazione del dizionario ad un pubblico internazionale, le qualifiche professionali sono date in inglese.

5. **I paesi:** La nazionalità e i nomi dei paesi di nascita o di residenza sono in inglese. Soprattutto per le biografie del XX sec. si sono adottati i nomi odierni delle nazioni, nell'ambito dell'ordinamento politico-geografico vigente. Per persone vissute prima del XX sec., si è tenuto conto dell'ordinamento politico in vigore nelle relative epoche. Per la storia antica si sono mantenute le denominazioni tradizionali (*Roman Empire, Athens, Persia*, ecc.). In mancanza d'indicazioni di luogo puntuali, si sono offerte informazioni generiche (*Arabia, South America, Africa*). Quando, in rari casi, la nazionalità, il luogo di nascita o di residenza, di solito forniti dalle fonti, non sono indicati espressamente, sono stati dedotti da altri dati. Sempre a proposito della nazionalità e dei luoghi di nascita o di residenza, una particolarità accomuna i paesi dell'Europa orientale, centrale e meridionale che appartennero all'impero Asburgico o alla Polonia, tre volte smembrata fra le potenze vincitrici: in questi contesti, tranne rare eccezioni, si è rinunciato ad indicare una nazionalità. Le informazioni di luogo presenti nell'opera abbracciano più di 180 paesi.
6. **Gli pseudonimi:** Sono registrati in ordine alfabetico. Si è tenuto conto di tutte le varianti conosciute. Si sono registrate anche le sole iniziali, usate come varianti della firma soprattutto nell'area slava, e in alcuni casi anche gli anonimi (*Author of...*).
7. **Le fonti:** Ogni voce cita, abbreviando i titoli, le fonti: si consulti per le abbreviazioni le "Abbreviazioni bibliografiche". L'elenco completo della bibliografia tratta dalle fonti è riportato nella "Elenco delle fonti". Le voci che non rimandano a fonti stampate sono state compilate unicamente sulla base di ricerche in Internet.

4. Criteri usati per la registrazione dei nomi e le trascrizioni fonetiche.

1. Le singole voci sono registrate in ordine alfabetico dall'a alla z.
Ä, ö, ü valgono ai fini dell'ordine alfabetico come ae,

oe, ue. Tutte le altre lettere accentate o fornite di segni diacritici (accenti gravi, acuti, circumflessi; tilde, cediglia, dieresi, ecc.), p.e.: â, ã, ä, ë, ê, ð, ñ, ò, si considerano alla pari di quelle che ne sono prive (a, e, c, l, i, z, ecc).

2. Nell'ordine alfabetico i rinvii precedono i voci uguali.
3. Non si fa differenza tra nomi e cognomi: si registrano indifferentemente sia persone note solo col nome di battesimo ed eventuali soprannomi, che quelle di cui si conosce il cognome e il nome di battesimo. I numeri romani o le preposizioni (von, de, di, ecc.) non vengono considerati.
4. I nomi doppi, con lineetta o senza, seguono in ordine alfabetico i nomi semplici.
5. Fra omonimi vale l'ordine cronologico.
6. L'elenco dei segni alfanumerici e di altri segni grafici precede la lettera a.

5. Particolarità nella registrazione dei nomi.

Si prega di notare le seguenti particolarità:

1. I nomi portoghesi e brasiliani si attengono alla prassi proposta dalla *Biblioteca Luso-Brasileira*: si registra al primo posto sempre l'ultimo dei cognomi, anche quando il personaggio di solito viene citato nella combinazione degli ultimi due cognomi.
2. I caratteri cirillici sono stati traslati dalla lingua originaria secondo le norme DIN 1460 (ж → ž, ш → š, ч → č).
3. Alcuni nomi e cognomi slavi, trascritti in caratteri latini soprattutto da fonti inglesi, americane e francesi, sono stati accolti nella forma ortografica data dalle fonti, quando mancava ogni documentazione sulla forma slava originaria. Pertanto i nomi slavi, oltre che con la desinenza originaria -iè, si possono trovare anche con le desinenze -itsch, -ich, ecc.
4. Le forme ortografiche antiche dei nomi tedeschi del passato (p. e.: Claus invece di Klaus o Boese invece di Böse), sono state collegate alle forme moderne per mezzo di rinvii.
5. Per i voll. dal X al XVI vale il criterio seguente: pseudonimi costruiti come nomi e cognomi sono registrati sotto il cognome. Pseudonimi costituiti da locuzioni in più termini sono riportati iniziando dalla prima parola, ma senza considerare gli articoli.

Indicaciones para el uso

1. Contenido y valor de la información

La literatura internacional existente sobre seudónimos es muy numerosa. Entre 400 y 500 publicaciones se ocupan detalladamente de esta cuestión, aunque desde un punto de vista regional o un aspecto científico concreto. Hasta ahora faltaba una enciclopedia global y completa. La presente *Internationale Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme*, Enciclopedia Internacional de Seudónimos, llena este vacío y es un proyecto único tanto en lo que respecta a su forma como por su amplitud. La *Internationale Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme* reúne por primera vez en una sola obra los seudónimos de todo el mundo y de todas las profesiones, épocas y tiempos.

La obra proporciona y descifra cerca de 635.000 seudónimos de aproximadamente 270.000 personas. Los tomos del 1 al 9 contienen una lista en orden alfabético de los nombres auténticos. Aquí se indican también el lugar y año de nacimiento, el lugar y año de muerte, profesión, nacionalidad, los seudónimos bajo los que se conocía a la persona y finalmente la fuente o fuentes utilizadas. En la segunda parte, que comprende los tomos 10 hasta 16, figuran los seudónimos ordenados de forma alfabética con sus respectivos nombres reales.

Para proporcionar al usuario una base de información lo más amplia posible se ha renunciado a una interpretación reducida del concepto de seudónimo. Se han incluido no sólo los seudónimos en el sentido estricto de la palabra como nombres de artistas, seudónimos literarios, anagramas, helenizaciones, latinizaciones o también identificaciones mistificadoras, (comunes sobre todo en las regiones ibérica y holandesa y también en el este de Asia). Además en muchos casos se encuentran sobrenombres, nombres de nacimiento y nombres adquiridos por matrimonio, nombres de orden o de Papa, pero también iniciales y abreviaciones de firmas (importantes en la región de habla húngara y eslava) así como abreviaturas. En menor número también se han incluido anónimos.

En la elaboración de la *Internationale Enzyklopädie der Pseudonyme* se han reunido y utilizado numerosas obras de consulta. Además, para facilitar al usuario la identificación de una persona buscada se ha intentado completar los nombres y los seudónimos con datos sobre la profesión, el país y la vida encontrados mediante investigaciones llevadas a cabo también por Internet. A pesar de todos los esfuerzos para garantizar el rigor y la integridad, puede ocurrir que en algunos casos aislados se hayan tomado errores o correspondencias equivocadas de las fuentes. Del mismo modo, no ha sido posible en todos los casos encontrar datos precisos sobre algunas personas.

En una entrada, los seudónimos están dispuestos en orden alfabético.

En la segunda parte de la edición (tomos 10 al 16) desde el seudónimo como entrada principal se remite a los nombres auténticos. Una entrada está dispuesta del siguiente modo:

Seudónimo [Apellido o concepto], *Nombre de pila y nombres adicionales* → Apellido auténtico de la persona, nombre (eventualmente nombres adicionales)

En caso de que un seudónimo sea empleado por varias personas, se citan los nombres auténticos en orden alfabético.

3. Contenido de las entradas

1. **Nombre.** Se indican el apellido, nombre así como, en caso necesario, nombres adicionales y variantes del nombre. Lo último aparece en paréntesis cuadrado []. Las variantes del nombre se indican en la entrada principal con “or” o “see also”. Una flecha (→) remite de una variante del nombre a la entrada principal.
2. **Datos de la vida:** En la publicación se citan todos los datos comprobados en las fuentes de información. En caso de que falte el año de nacimiento o de muerte se indican en paréntesis cuadrado datos conocidos sobre la vida, p.ej. [1835] o [1875-1905]. Datos de años dudosos o fuera de lo normal van acompañados de un signo de interrogación o están puestos en paréntesis redondo.
3. **Datos sobre lugares:** Se han tomado según las fuentes de información. Sólo en casos excepcionales (p.ej. capitales) se han traducido al inglés o al alemán. En el caso de datos ampliados sobre lugares (p.ej. Bernau bei Berlin o Kostelec u Holešova) se presenta el dato con el signo de barra (Ej.: Bernau/Berlin o Kostelec/Holešova). Además se registran datos regionales (como distrito, departamento, etc.) con “gov” o “district”.
4. **Profesiones:** Las designaciones de profesión deben describir el campo de acción de la persona de la forma más exacta posible. En algunos casos no se trata de una verdadera designación de profesión sino de indicaciones

sobre relaciones de parentesco o funciones representativas realizadas. Para facilitar el uso internacional de la enciclopedia se dan las designaciones de profesión en lengua inglesa.

5. **Países:** La nacionalidad o el país de nacimiento y residencia constan en lengua inglesa. Para períodos de vida que tuvieron lugar durante el siglo XX se han nombrado los países tomando como base el orden geopolítico actual y la actual designación de la nación. En el caso de personas que vivieron antes, se ha tenido en cuenta la disposición histórica de las naciones. Para la historia antigua se ha mantenido la designación usual (Roman Empire, Athens, Persia, etc.). Cuando faltan correspondencias nacionales exactas se han utilizado designaciones regionales (Arabia, South America, Africa). En general, la nacionalidad y el país de nacimiento y residencia de una persona se ha tomado de los datos de las fuentes de información. Cuando ha faltado una indicación de este tipo, en casos aislados, se ha inferido el dato del país de los lugares de nacimiento y muerte u otras indicaciones sobre el tema. Una singularidad en la indicación de la nacionalidad y del lugar de nacimiento y muerte la constituyen los países del Este, el centro y el Sudeste europeos que pertenecieron a la monarquía de los Habsburgo así como también la Polonia tripartita. Aquí, salvo en algunas excepciones, se ha renunciado a la indicación del país. En la publicación se encuentran referencias de más de 180 naciones.
6. **Seudónimos:** Se indican en orden alfabético. Se han tomado las variaciones y los modos alternativos de escribirlos que se conocen. Aquí también se citan las iniciales como variantes de firma, que sobre todo en la región eslava tienen un papel importante, así como, en algunos casos, anónimos (Autor of ...).
7. **Fuentes:** Cada entrada menciona fuentes en las que aparece la persona. Las fuentes se citan de forma abreviada. Para descifrar las fuentes abreviadas se remite al apartado "Abreviaturas de las fuentes". Los datos bibliográficos completos de las fuentes utilizadas se encuentran en el apartado "Lista de fuentes". Las entradas sin indicación sobre una fuente son resultado, exclusivamente, de investigaciones por Internet.

4. Clasificación

1. Las entradas están dispuestas en orden alfabético de la a hasta la z.

Aquí se clasifican ä, ö, ü, ø, œ, ō como ae, oe, ue. Los demás signos con acentos (como grave, agudo, circunflejo, tilde, Háček, diéresis, etc.), p.ej. â, ấ, ầ, ë, ë́, ë̀, ç, ħ, ĩ, ž, se clasifican con la correspondiente letra básica del alfabeto (a, e, c, l, i, z, etc.).

2. Ante voces semejantes se encuentran referencias.
3. En la clasificación no se distingue entre nombres y apellidos personales. Nombres personales con apodos y apellidos de familia con nombre se tratan del mismo modo. En la clasificación de nombres personales se omiten los números romanos y del mismo modo las preposiciones von, de, di, etc.
4. Los nombres dobles con o sin guión se encuentran ordenados con nombres semejantes.
5. En caso de nombres idénticos se sigue la clasificación de forma cronológica.
6. Alfanuméricos y otros signos van por delante de la letra a.

5. Disposición de los nombres

En la disposición de los nombres se tienen en cuenta las siguientes particularidades:

1. En los nombres brasileños y portugueses, siguiendo el ejemplo de la "Biblioteca Luso-Brasileira" se toma el último apellido familiar como nombre, aunque el autor normalmente se cite bajo una combinación de sus dos últimos apellidos.
2. Los signos cirílicos se han transcrito de la lengua original según la norma DIN 1460 (ж → ž, ш → š, ч → č).
3. En algunas formas de nombres eslavos, sobre todo de fuentes inglesas, americanas y francesas, en las que no figuraba una forma original eslava en los materiales, se ha dejado el nombre tal como aparecía escrito en la fuente. De este modo, nombres p.ej. que en su origen eslavo terminan en -iĭ aparecen también con la terminación -itsch, -ich, etc.
4. En el caso de nombres alemanes antiguos existe la posibilidad de diversas formas de escritura como p.ej. Claus por Klaus, o Boese por Böse. Las distintas formas se registran mediante remisiones.
5. En los tomos del 10 al 16 figura como sigue: Seudónimos que tienen la estructura de nombre y apellido se colocan con el apellido. Seudónimos que se entienden como un concepto compuesto figuran bajo la primera palabra y sin tener en cuenta los artículos.
