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The Annual Bibliography aims and current changes

The purpose of the *Bibliography of the International Arthurian Society* (BIAS), which continues the annual bibliography previously published by the International Arthurian Society since 1949 as *Bibliographical Bulletin of the International Arthurian Society / Bulletin Bibliographique de la Société Internationale Arthurienne* (without any interruption in the numerical sequence of annual volumes) is, year by year, to draw attention to all scholarly books and articles directly concerned with the *matière de Bretagne*. Subjects which are only indirectly concerned with it, such as the origins of courtly love, are deliberately excluded. Also excluded are popular works, general surveys found in histories of literature and most studies which deal with the Arthurian tradition after the sixteenth century. Within these limits, the Bibliography aims to include all books, reviews and articles published in the year preceding its appearance, an exception being made for earlier studies which have been omitted inadvertently. Back volumes (I-LI) are available in electronic format at <http://bbsia.cellam.fr/>. From this issue (LXIV) the preliminary material (list of officers of the society) and the list of members are no longer published with the annual bibliography. These items are published online on the society's website at <http://www.internationalarthuriansociety.com/>. From 2013 the society will publish *JIAS (Journal of the International Arthurian Society)*, a new journal, but at the same time a publication which provides continuity with the research section previously published in *BBIAS/BBSIA*.

The editor would like to thank Dr Frank Brandsma and his team for all their support during the transition, and work done on the bibliography files in the past couple of years.

Editorial conventions and instructions for contributors

Each national branch of the Arthurian Society is responsible for its own section of the Bibliography. Each section is divided into four parts: I. Texts, Translations and Adaptations; II. Critical and Historical Studies; III. Reviews; IV. Reprints; V. Doctoral Dissertations/Higher Degree Theses. The contents of each section are arranged in the alphabetical order of authors' names. As often as

possible a brief, objective account is given of the contents of each study listed in the Bibliography. For practical purposes, as well as to conform to a decision taken at the Second Triennial Arthurian Congress, these digests are given in English, French or German. Each section of the Bibliography is printed in alphabetical order according to nationality. The first publication listed for each year is given the number one; the rest follows in numerical order down to the end of the Bibliography. Any reference to the Bibliography should therefore include the number of the Bulletin, the year and the number of the individual publication, e. g. *BBIAS*, I, 1949, 20. At the end of the Bibliography are printed two indexes, one of authors and one of subject-matter. The indexes are prepared by the bibliographers of the national branches.

The bibliographers of each national branch are asked to submit the copy of their contribution electronically to Dr. Raluca Radulescu, Editor of *BIAS*, *by 1st May at the latest*. Contributions should be formatted according to the guidelines supplied by the Editor. Email: r.radulescu@bangor.ac.uk.

Die neue zweisprachige Reclam-Ausgabe des *Iwein* Hartmanns von Aue kombiniert einen zuverlässigen mhd. Text nach B (sog. *Gießner Iwein*) mit einer am mhd. Original orientierten nhd. Übersetzung. Das Problem der Divergenzen zwischen den Fassungen B und A wird

gelöst, indem Lücken in B aus A ergänzt und Plusverse in B gegen die ‘üblichen’ an A orientierten Editionen durch Einrückung markiert sind. Vereinzelte marginale Anmerkungen im Editionstext machen auf Besonderheiten in B (wie falsche Initialen o.ä.) aufmerksam. Irrigernd wirkt die inhaltsorientierte – moderne – Kapiteleinteilung, die eben gerade keine Entsprechung in der Überlieferung hat. Der Erschließung des Texts dienen eine kurze Abhandlung zu Textgestalt und Übersetzung, ein – recht knapp geratener – Kommentar, ein Literaturverzeichnis sowie ein wesentliche Forschungsansätze skizzierendes Nachwort. - 10 “*Melerantz von Frankreich*”. Der “*Meleranz*” des Pleier. Nach der Karlsruher Handschrift. Edition - Untersuchungen - Stellenkommentar, hg. von Markus STEFFEN. Berlin: ESV, 2011. Texte des späten Mittelalters und der frühen Neuzeit, 48.

Mit der vorliegenden *Melerantz*-Ausgabe ist ein weiterer Text der sog. Nachklassischen Artusliteratur vorbildlich erschlossen. Der Verf. bietet den Text nach der einzigen erhaltenen Handschrift in einer sehr zurückhaltend normalisierten, unmittelbar am Codex orientierten Fassung. Ganz bewusst wird der überlieferte Text des 15. Jh.s nicht in die Sprache der Entstehungszeit zurücktransferiert. Für das Textverständnis sehr hilfreich sind dabei die eingefügte moderne Interpunktions, ein Stellenkommentar und zahlreiche weitere Hilfsmittel wie ein Namenregister, ein umfängliches Literaturverzeichnis und ein (allerdings etwas heterogenes) ‘normales’ Register. Dem Editionstext voraus gehen eine Forschungsskizze, Untersuchungen zur Handschrift (Einrichtung, Sprache, Graphie, Provenienz) und zum Schreiber Gabriel Lindenast-Sattler. (J.W.)

Der Band bietet eine unkommentierte deutsche Versübersetzung einer Auswahl von Fabeln und Lais der Marie de France (*Chevrefoil*, *Le Fresne*, *Laaval*, *Equitan*, *Les deus amanz*, *Laüstic* und *Bisclavet*), dazu der Owein-Episode aus dem *L'Espurgatoire Seint Patriz*. Der Übersetzung der Lais liegt die Ausgabe von Alfred Ewert (1952) zugrunde. (C.D.)

- 12 WOLFRAM VON ESCHENBACH, *Parzival*, übers. von Peter KNECHT, mit Bildern von Dieter ASMUS. Nachwort von Volker MERTENS. Stuttgart: Reclam, 2011, 426 S.

Die Schmuckausgabe ist mit 18 Bildern von Dieter Asmus ausgestattet, die im Stil des von ihm geprägten *Neuen Realismus* angefertigt wurden. Sie illustrieren nicht einfach die markantesten Szenen, sondern setzen mit einer eigenwilligen Auswahl eigene Akzente und geben dem Text ein glattes und buntes Gepräge. Das Nachwort ordnet die Bilder in den narrativen Kontext ein. Abgedruckt wird nicht der mittelhochdeutsche Text, sondern lediglich die bekannte und häufig gedruckte Übersetzung von Peter Knecht (*BBIAS*, XLVI, 1994, 37). (N.B.)

Am Beispiel mhd. Gralromane werden drei Aspekte mittelalterlicher genealogischer Vorstellungen untersucht: “[d]ie Frage des Ursprungs” (Spitzenahn), “die Frage nach Zyklenbildung” (Nachkommenschaft und verwandtschaftliche Konstellationen) und “die ‘Genealogie der Texte’ und ‘Texte als Genealogie’” (55). Die untersuchten Dichtungen (v. a. *Parzival*, *Jüngerer Titrel*, *Buch der Abenteuer*, *Lohengrin*) setzen dabei unterschiedliche Akzentuierungen, die als ein produktives Arbeiten am genealogischen System der Gralsippe verstanden werden können. (M.G.)
